Men det var Dagen – og jeg begynte med redaktørenes Harris-preferanse:

Historiker Victor Davis Hanson⁵ (Hoover Inst., Stanford Univ.; GBNews $-03.10.24^6 - \text{spør}$): "-How do you assess her [Harris⁷] as a presidential candidate, her intelligence, her qualifications for the job – would she be the least qualified president in US history?

-Yeah, I think she would – but it's not a matter of controversy that she would be the most left-wing, because, outside appraisal groups, surveys have shown that she's to the left of Bernie Sanders. We should remember in 2020, the powers that ... removed ... Sanders from contention, through a lot of machinations, precisely because he was considered too leftwing – now they didn't do that with Harris, because she didn't last that long, she dropped out in December. "Donald Trump won the 2024 election in part because the left's hysterical style of attacking Trump no longer worked." Victor Davis Hanson; The Addicted, Petty, and Hysterical Left; 23. januar – Davis Hanson forstatt:

"After a decade of this unhinged furor, it proved worthless in winning public support – and for two simple reasons.

They were not rigging the election; they were fortifying it. And they believe the public needs to understand the system's fragility in order to ensure that democracy in America endures."

Oppsummert – med The Daily Caller's Greg Price: ¹⁸ "So the election wasn't rigged. There was only a secret cabal of powerful elites and corporate interests that worked together to overhaul election laws, influence media coverage, and convince big tech to crush dissent".

Victor Davis Hanson: "-So we have early voting in most states..." "-So under the guise of Covid, in March, April, May of 2020, teams of Democratic lawyers went to Michigan, went to Pennsylvania, went to Georgia etc., and they cherry-picked particular states and they said it's not fair to the dispossessed and the underclass to have to deal with Covid and show up at the polls. So, we want to say that if you mail in a ballot it doesn't have to be there on the night of the election – 10 days in some states – or some people, you know, they're confused, they don't speak English, they only have their first name, so if they don't have the complete name, that shouldn't count, or they don't have the right

address, and of course a registrar can't, you know, they can't be accurate every time, so if you get a ballot they mail to you and it doesn't match the ballot, maybe that's okay, and maybe if you apply for a driver's license, you apply for unemployment, you apply for disability, you apply for a building permit – whatever contact you have in a state agency, they will mail you a registration packet and which will come to a ballot. So you can register in six different areas, a different, slightly different, name, same address. So my point is, that when they did all of this, suddenly election day in these states was only 30% of the electorate participated; 70% had either voted early or through mail ballot, which was highly irregular, but then, when you looked at the rejection rate by states, it was no longer the four to six percents of ballots that were rejected, it dropped precipitously to 0.3, 0.2, 0.4, so, with double the ballots swarming these registrars and then they were not authenticating them at the same rate they had done in the past, people got very skeptical.

And then they started, they had these new terms they sprung on the American people; ballot harvesty..."

Fremdeles Davis Hanson:²⁰ "-I was very upset about the Stanford University Daily Newspaper, that attacks Scot Atlas and myself for having conservative views basically. I sent a letter and they said, "You have to have a hyperlink for every story so one this ... for every point you make."

So one of the things I said was affidavits have come in alleging voter fraud, and there had been lawsuits, both true. It doesn't mean that the election was changed necessarily, but I just did the hyperlink. When I went on to Google to find affidavits or lawsuits, I had to go through, I don't know, 80, 90 hits. And they were things like Reuters, AP, New York Times, all of them, the marquee labels that a venue would like. And what do they say? Fake affidavits, fake affidavits, fake affidavits, fake lawsuits, fake law.

And then you get down to a local TV station in Pennsylvania says that all of these affidavits are pretty accurate because people saw this. So there's a nexus between the bias media and then the way that, that is again, force multiplied by Twitter, Facebook, Google."

"Acting Secretary of Defense Christopher Miller dismissed President Trump's order prior to January 6 to use "any and all" military assets to keep the demonstrations safe."

The current committee is not bipartisan. House Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-Calif.) forbade Republican nominees traditionally selected by the House minority leader to serve on the committee.

No speaker had ever before rejected the minority party's nominees to a select House committee.

Pelosi's own cynical criteria for Republican participation were twofold: Any willing minority Republican members had to have voted to impeach Donald Trump while having no realistic chance of being reelected in 2022.

Of some 210 Republican House members, that left just Representatives Liz Cheney (R-Wyo.) and Adam Kinzinger (R-Ill.) who were willing and able to fit Pelosi's profile.

A real investigation would have ignited argumentation, cross-examination, and disagreements – the sort of give-and-take for which congressional committees are famous.

In contrast, the January 6 show trial features no dissenting views. Its subtext was right out of the Soviet minister of Internal Affairs Lavrentiy Pavlovich Beria's credo: "Show me the man and I'll show you the crime".

If Donald Trump was not considering a third run for the presidency, would the committee even have existed?

Its slick Hollywood-produced optics demonstrate that the committee has no interest in inconvenient facts. Most of those charges despite being called an insurrection, no one has been charged with insurrection, and most of those charges are misdemeanors, like parading in the Capitol or walking on restricted grounds.

Nonetheless, these defendants are subjected to - it's not even right to call it an impartial proceedings in Washington D.C. - but highly biased judges and juries rendering the fate of what happens with these defendants either in court or in pleadings.

So we now have 1,300 total.

But what was really egregious... is, a few weeks ago, Matthew Graves, the U.S. Attorney for the District of Columbia – a Biden campaign advisor turned Biden prosecutor – warned that his office

planned to round up thousands more J6ers. People who were just standing on campgrounds outside that afternoon. No clue that they were trespassing, certainly breaking the law, but he plans to at least double this total caseload as this DOJ continues to retaliate against Americans who protested Joe Biden's election three years ago."

"- So at the same time, Matthew Graves is threatening to charge these people, you have the DC appellate court who might overturn this completely. But that doesn't stop people like Matthew Graves and the DOJ. They just want the talking points. They want the threat and they want to use whatever weaponization of the law to criminalize political dissent and warn people: if you try to do this again after the 2024 election, here's what's coming for you." (Hør ellers to av de nå frigitte samt en involvert advokat – med Stephen K. Bannon 21. februar; se note.²⁶)

Kelly: "-At least 300 J6ers have been charged with §1512(c)(2), convicted, resulting in years in prison. And of course, this is two of the charges against Donald Trump and Jack Smith's fourth indictment in Washington.

The Supreme Court is going to look at what's called a splintered appellate court ruling that barely upheld DOJ's intentionally misinterpretation of the language of that statute to say, 'If you interfered in any way with proceedings that day, the counting of the electoral college vote, either before, during, or after the joint session adjourned, it doesn't matter. You still obstructed this official proceeding that makes you a felon and it's punishable by up to 20 years in prison.'"

"-Now, the people who were at Trump's speech were still there... So you take certain things that have happened so far – why in the world would Hamas, who hates him, and feels they can talk to Biden and Blinken and Sullivan, why would they be more likely to get a deal in fear of him coming in? In other words, the reductionist answer is, they know that they're getting away with murder, and he won't let them do that. Why all of a sudden is the Iranian prime minister on television saying there's no, we never tried to kill the president of the United States?"

"-He's unpredictable... and unpredictability according to – he has opponents that think that's dangerous, but that's not the way the real world works. When somebody is unpredictable, then you're

more careful about them, and all of these concessions that he's gotten before he's entered office, are not because people like him and they're not because they were forced to do it..."

- "-So what this MAGA movement was, it was a holistic assault on a system that has become calcified ... and has no connection with reality."
- "-I think what the whole MAGA thing, the idea of Trump, was that people use very sophisticated vocabulary and resumés to do really awful things; so you scream and yell and that tears off the veneer, and then you're left with a reality and you can judge it one or the other."

- "-There's a complete re-examination right now of what we've seen. And it's not a political thing, it's more of a cultural, social counterrevolution. Now, I think it's kind of be boiled down as: these people are not capable people, they're very dangerous people, and the fact where they went to college or what color their skin is or what sexual orientation they are or we don't care. We don't care what the resumé say. We just want to judge people on what they do. And they're found wanting. And that was what the election, I think, was about. It's not, it wasn't so much about Donald Trump, it was about *this* stuff that I'm talking about."

"-And I always say: When it's too dirty for the CIA, you give it to USAID." (Mike Benz³⁰)
